Themes and Meanings. Lillian is primary in Ladders to Fire and Seduction of the Minotaur, Djuna in The Four-chambered Heart and Children of the Albatross, Sabina in A Spy in the House of Love, but the three women—all fragmented types of Nin's personality—appear in the works as personifications of the multiple nature of composite womanhood.
