Craniofacial anomalies (CFAs) are congenital abnormalities in the bone or soft tissue of the face or head and comprise a wide range of heterogeneous conditions with many associated syndromes.

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Braces for Craniofacial Anomalies

For children with craniofacial anomalies that affect the bones of the upper or lower jaws, braces and other orthodontic treatments may be prescribed as part of the treatment to correct the condition. Orthodontics are often needed prior to most surgical procedures associated with craniofacial anomalies.

Orthodontic Management of Craniofacial Anomalies, A ...

As the orthodontic management is commonly needed prior to most surgical procedures associated with craniofacial anomalies, management protocols should be based on a precise understanding of the exact nature of the anomalies as certain mechanics may be provided efficiently, safely and with acceptable durability, while at the same time, other techniques might be not effectively applied with some complications.
