Christian Influence in English Poetry

The new Christian poetry was more subjective rather than objective, lyric rather than epic. The older poetry penetrated the new and the spirit of the new transformed the old. The historical importance of Anglo-Saxon religious poetry as observed by W. P. Kerr lies in the "blending of Germania, the original Teutonic civilization with the ideas and sentiments of Christendom.

Characteristics of Old English Poetry | The Classroom

In terms of the structure of a poem, Old English poetry has a distinct sort of line and meter. Lines in Old English poetry are broken into two sections. These are called half lines, or verses. Between each is a pause. These two lines have "feet," the determination of the stressed and unstressed syllables. This is what determines the meter of the verse.

Old English Religious Poetry

Poetry and Architecture
