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Virginia Reportable Disease List Reporting of the following diseases is required by state law (Sections 32.1-3 UU6 UH and HU32.1-3 UU7 UH of the Code of Virginia and 12 VAC 5-90-80 and 12 VAC 5-90-90 of the Board of Health Regulations for Disease Reporting and Control -

### **2VAC5**

2VAC5-30-30. Reportable Disease List. A. The Board of Agriculture and Consumer Services declares suspected or confirmed cases of the following multiple-species diseases to be reportable by the persons enumerated in 2VAC5-30-20. Conditions identified by an asterisk (\*) are foreign animal diseases.
